Facts About Foglemans—

Articles about the Eli and Ruth Hinshaw Fogleman family began in the September—December 2007 issue of the *Fogleman Newsletter* and continued in the following two quarterlies. A son of Eli and Ruth, John Andrew Fogleman, was born 07 Apr 1841 in Orange County, NC, and died 22 May 1922 in Alamance County, NC. He married SARAH A. SILER 07 Aug 1859 in Chatham County, North Carolina, daughter of JOHN SILER and MERIAM CARTER. She was born 06 Jun 1837 in Chatham County, NC, and died 09 Jul 1917. (Note: Writer has a discrepancy in the death year. One version has May 22, 1922 and another version is May 22, 1928.) Sarah was sister to Elizabeth Siler, wife of Oliver who was a brother to John Andrew.

At the age of 22, John Andrew enlisted on 06 Mar 1862 at Chatham County in Co. G, 36th Infantry Regiment, North Carolina for the Civil War. He was present or accounted for until wounded in the left hand at Gettysburg, PA on July 1, 1863. He returned to duty prior to 4 Oct 1863 when he was captured at Bristol Station, VA., and was confined at Old Capitol Prison, Washington, DC until transferred to Point Lookout on or about Nov. 1, 1864 and transferred to Venus Point, Savannah River, GA where he was received 15 Nov 1864 for exchange.

Reported absent without leave on 20 Dec 1864. He mustered out on 20 Dec. 1864. Tomas H. Fogleman of Liberty (NC) said that when a small boy his Grandpa Thomas Eli would tell him to remember the things that he was telling him as his grandfather worked in the fields. He explained that "at the time of John Andrew's release, John Andrew, along with other soldiers, had to walk home from Georgia. One night they stayed in a house that appeared to be haunted even though the owner had cautioned the soldiers about the haunts. Later that night, the sounds of a log chain rattling up and down the stairs of the house were heard and a few of the soldiers immediately left the house. The remaining soldiers left before the sunrise after the same chain and other sounds became worse." Both, John Andrew and Sarah, are buried at the Pleasant Hill Church Cemetery, Alamance County, NC. John and Sarah Siler Fogleman had six (6) children. An infant was still born prior to John leaving for the war, and a second child, Philip Andrew, born on 27 June 1862, only lived a few days beyond three months. The loss must have been devastating for Sarah as well as for John to learn during time away from a wife of only two and one-half years. The children of JOHN FOGLEMAN and SARAH SILER are:

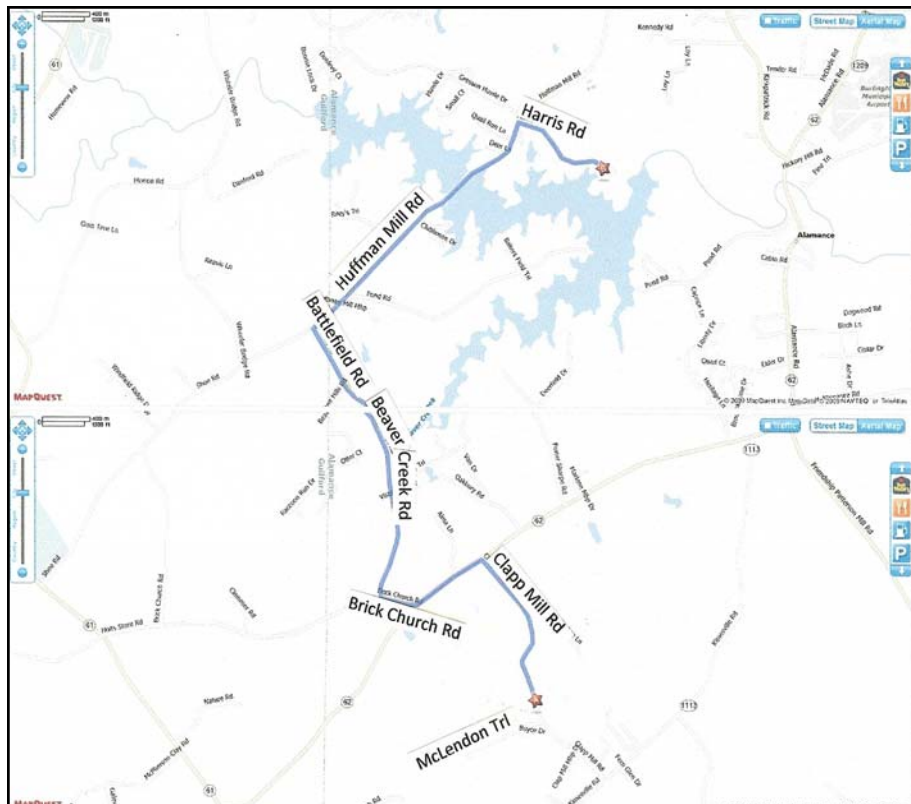

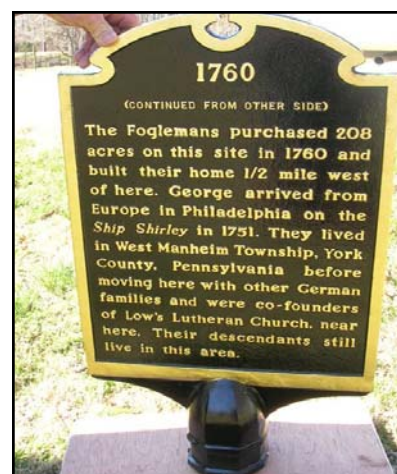

George & Catherine Fogleman Historical Marker Project

Little did Fogleman descendants realize at the time of the family reunion in 2000, that it would take nine years to locate and establish a historic marker for recognizing the location of the George and Catherine Fogleman home place. How had the families lost track where their ancestors had first settled? The group visited two other sites before the final destination was reached. Although the marker shows a date of 1760, according to Orange County (NC) Deed Book 2, page 503-504, George Fogleman purchased the 208 acres from Henry McCulloch and Joshua Willocks on 24 May 1761. The Indendure read “made the twenty fourth day of May in the first year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George the third...”

While a large number of people helped with this project, none are more important than Ellen Fogleman Whitworth, Wade C. Euliss, Darrell B. Clapp, and William “Bill” Moran. Ms. Whitworth held a map drawing that showed “This deed was main 1771 the blue lines (original had been drawn in a blue color) to old George Fogleman.” Mr. Euliss provided a stack of deeds dating between 1887–present day as they pertained to his property. Mr. Clapp assisted Mr. Moran with various details as they related to the deeds and provided a few of the drawings or maps involving the property. But it was Mr. Moran who spent untold hours reviewing more than two-hundred deeds before drawing maps from the deeds as they relate to the tracts that were split throughout the years. This method created a trail and history about the property and their owners, most being Fogleman descendants.

The material was compiled and submitted to the Alamance County (NC) Historic Properties Commission who denied our request to recognize the original tract of land as a historic property. On our own, the fundraiser for the marker began in late 2008, and \$1,325 was collected for the marker that was transported in February 2009 from Sewah Studios, Inc. in Marietta, Ohio to Trudie Fogleman McPherson of Snow Camp (NC).
